## Care advice for tables with surfaces in high pressure laminate and core of MDF or chipboard

Laminate table tops have a high pressure laminate surface that is durable, easy to maintain and hygienic. Daily cleaning is done with hand dishwashing liquid and water, or with mild detergent

More difficult spots can possibly be removed with water and chlorine (mixing ratio 1:1) or with T-Red, thinner or with acetone (without oil). If these solvents are used, one must see that there is good supply of fresh air. Note that the core of MDF or edge moldings of wood does not withstand these cleaning agents. On the edges, only dry cloth (not moistened) should be used.

Never cut with sharp objects directly on the table top.

Never place hot objects directly on the table top. Always use heat-insulating mats.
The warranty does not apply if damage is caused by knives or other scratching objects or by strong chemicals etc. Furthermore, the guarantee does not apply if abrasive is used such as scouring powder, steel wool, nylon sponge or the like because these make scratches in the surface.

Keep the above mentioned in mind so you will be able to enjoy Your Horred's furniture for many years.
