

Care instructions Desktop / Furniture Linoleum

Linoleum is primed from the supplier, which makes the surface easy to clean. Surface durability is good against the most common spots that can occur on the table but is not resistant to prolonged action of alkali. It is important to wipe off spills of color substances as soon as possible (ink, coffee, wine, juice etc.).

If you want to keep the naturally matt surface, care can be taken with soap-based detergents, type soap wax or similar soft wax.

During and after assembly: Remove all stains and fingerprints as soon as possible during assembly. Use a damp cloth and a pH neutral detergent (alternatively ready-mixed linoleum cleaner). Dry the surface after cleaning. Adhesive is most easily removed by adding a water-dampened cloth over the adhesive spot for about 10 minutes. When the glue softens, it can be removed without damaging the surface. Wipe the surface with a damp cloth and a pH neutral detergent. Dry the surface.

Daily care: Clean the surface with a soap-based cleaning product diluted in water, alternatively hand dishwashing detergent or pH neutral detergent for light soiling. For harder stains, a white nylon cloth can be used to rub easily with the cleaning. Dry the surface after cleaning.

Periodic care: To maintain a fine linoleum surface, clean with neutral detergent. Then, if necessary, the surface is treated with soap wax, e.g. Welin's wax.

General for protecting the surface: Use dense substrates for flower pots, plates, coffee cups etc. Remove all stains as soon as possible and dry the surface after cleaning.
